

Typical Day at Preschool

- Students Arrive 9:15am
- Circle Time: prayer, pledge, calendar, weather, phonics song, bathroom
- Class rotations through each learning area: Fine motor, large motor, literacy, math/science
- Snack
- Dismissal: 11:45am for 3 year olds
- Dismissal: 12:15pm for 4 year olds

Special Activities

Music: We also include music once a week for the four year old program and every other week for the three year old class.

Children's Chapel: We teach a bible lesson every week and Pastor Jon also comes once a week to discuss our stories.

Library Time: Our local librarian comes to read stories once a month to each class.

Special Events:

There are also field trips for the four year old class and special family activities for both classes. A few of our family favorites are the Christmas program and graduation celebration.

Arrival/Departure

Both classes will use our circle drive and red sidewalk. Upon arrival, a teacher will get your child out of the car from our car line. Teachers will escort your child to the red sidewalk for dismissal.

Snack

You provide the snack/activity fee of \$50.00 at the beginning of the year and we provide snacks the whole year to both classes.

How will my child learn?

We break our preschool into four learning areas throughout the day and each group of students rotate through each area. Below is a brief overview of each area:

1. **Fine Motor:** Strengthens the student's muscles for writing, using scissors, proper pencil grasps and gives them proper positional and spatial awareness.
2. **Math/Science:** Numbers, shapes and colors are explored, along with patterns and graphing. Students will also participate in various science experiments and exploration throughout the year.

3. **Literacy:** Letters, sounds, sequencing and retelling stories are explored. Rhyming and syllables are also introduced in this area.
4. **Large Motor:** Development of the large muscles through activities such as running, hopping, jumping, crawling, learning balance, body awareness and control.
