

Instructions for Online Worship:

Before the worship begins, find a candle and a bowl of water. In the same way we light the candles as we begin worship – signifying the presence of Jesus as the light of the world – light the candle in your home. The space where you are at this moment is sacred space – it is a space that has been set aside for the special purpose of worship.

The bowl of water is your remembrance of baptism. Take a second and dip your finger in the water. Then trace the sign of the cross on your forehead. On the day of your baptism, you were given the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ. You are a child of God, created, redeemed, and sanctified by God.

We will be celebrating Holy Communion for this weekend's worship. If you would like to bake the same bread we will be using for communion—see the weekly emailing for a recipe. If you don't have time to bake the bread, just find bread and wine/juice around the house.
